## Visiting the school

Parents and visitors to the school are required to enter the school premises via the main school entrance on Burke Street. All visitors must sign in and out and wear an official visitor's lanyard while on the premises.

## Late arrival to school

In the event of a student arriving late, they must be signed in by their parent/ guardian at the school office and present a late pass to their teacher.

If pupils are to be removed from the school premises during the school day, the parent/guardian/authorised person must sign the child 'out' of the school and back 'in' to the school upon their return.



**Please observe road rules around our school for the safety of all of our children.**

- \* Schools have 40km zone.
- \* Parking behind the church is TEACHER ONLY parking, it is too unsafe because children walk in this area.
- \* Please use the children's crossing on Burns, Kars St and Burke St.

There are **five minute** parking bays in Burke Street outside the school entrance. Your co-operation in only parking in this area for the specified time would be appreciated. These parking bays are for **quick pick up and drop off** and for students leaving early due to appointments and illness.

Likewise we also ask parents to respect the parking restriction on the disabled parking area.
