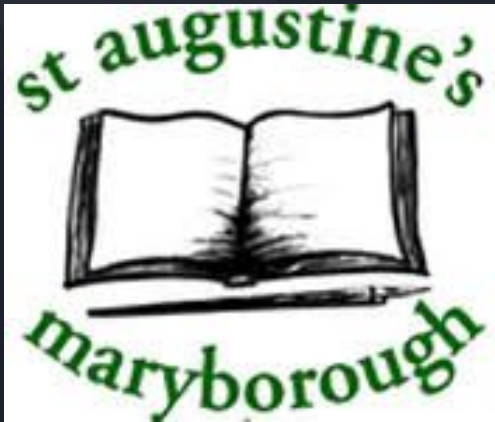


Feeling Safe at St Augustine's

What happens at St Augustine's to help the students be safe?

The teachers talk to and support the students.

We have consistent rules that encourage safety (like age restricted areas).

Students who are unsafe, receive consequences (like a Stop Sheet).

We wash our hands and have first aid to keep students safe.

All adults sign in at the office and do checks to say they can work with children.

Students can discuss their issues at Student Voice meetings.

There is always a teacher on yard duty to help keep kids safe.

Teachers in the staff room can help if you get badly injured .

STAR behaviour



We teach students to behave like stars.

We do a Behaviour Blitz when we see STAR behaviour being broken.

Students who represent STAR behaviours are rewarded.
